



Guidelines for Internships, Summer Schools and similar activities

Maximum number of "thesis points".

The maximum number of thesis points awarded for Internships, Summer Schools or similar activities is **2.0**. Thesis Points up to a maximum of **0.6** can be awarded for **ONE** Summer School or similar activity. Thesis Points up to a maximum of **one** can be awarded for **ONE** Internship.

Evaluation of Internship/ Summer Schools or similar activities

For participation in an Internship/Summer School or similar activity to be awarded points, the following conditions must be met:

- a) approval must be obtained **before** participation.

- b) the student must present the relative Internship documentation from the "Job Guidance" Office or a certificate of attendance for the Summer School or similar activity ;
- c) the student must submit a written report or an examination certificate/diploma;
- d) the Summer School or similar activity must be intensive;
- e) the Internship Coordinator of the MEIS will evaluate the degree of relevance between the content of the Internship/Summer School or similar activity and the MEIS.

Criteria for awarding "thesis points" for the internship

Points are awarded on the basis of the relevance of the internship to the subjects of the degree course and on the length of the internship¹. The table below illustrates the criteria for awarding credits.

Relevance	Length of internship		
	< two months	2-3 months	> 4 months
1	0.2	0.4	0.6
2	0.4	0.6	0.8
3	0.6	0.8	1.0

¹ Students who participate in the LLP-Erasmus "Student Mobility for Placement" Programme are not allowed to have thesis points recognized.
